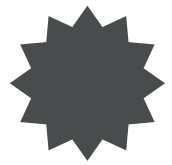

- Have emergency services told us to leave home?
- Do we know where we are going to stay - do they take pets?
- Do we know who will look after our pets?
- Do we know how to get there safely - do we have appropriate leashes/ crates / transport devices?
- Does our vehicle have enough fuel to get to safety? Is it full?
- Have we turned off the power (electricity), gas and water to the house?
- Have we closed and locked the house and provided somewhere safe for our pets, with appropriate food and water (if we are leaving them at home)?
- Have we packed our evacuation and pet emergency kit?
- Final kit check: Have we packed important medications?
- Final kit check: Have we packed all important documents?
- Have we checked on our neighbours, or informed them of our plan?
